What is genealogy?

Genealogy, also known as family history, is the study of families and the tracing of their lineages.

Genealogists use oral interviews, historical records, genetic analysis, and family trees to obtain information about a family and to demonstrate kinship and pedigrees of its members.

When I started...

- ▶ Since I was adopted, I had no knowledge of my biological family. My only source of information was from my mom.
- ▶ My only clues were one page of my adoption decree and a receipt from the hospital I was born in. They both listed my biological mothers name as Rose Becker
- ▶ When I started my search for my biological family over 25 years ago, I didn't have the online computer-based research we have today.
- ▶ My search started with contacting the states of Florida (where I was born) and New York (where my adoption was finalized)
- ▶ I searched out groups like ALMA (adoptees liberty movement association) to assist me in how to get information.
- ▶ I spent countless hours in the NYC Public library going through birth records searching for persons born 1945 - 1954 and with the correct name.
- ▶ I joined groups and signed up with adoption registries throughout the US.

Best practice for researching

- ▶ Always look for free or inexpensive places to research
- ▶ Look for groups relating to your research on Facebook and Yahoo.
- ▶ Use Google to research locations, old maps, and historical information.
- ▶ If you buy a subscription to anything related to research, make sure you are using it. If not cancel your subscription and renew when you know you will use it to its fullest.
- ▶ Use all parts of genealogy, Family Trees, Research and DNA matches.
- ▶ REMEMBER TO SUPPORT YOUR LOCAL LIBRARY!!!!
- ▶ They have a lot of way to help you research your family for free.

Places to search for records and information

- ▶ Ancestry.com® has over 20 billion records including all of the US Census records, birth, death index, marriage, immigration records. Basic subscriptions is \$24.99/Month. A six month account is less per month, A free account is available with limited usage.
- ▶ FamilySearch® is a nonprofit website offering genealogical records and software. It is operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and is closely connected with the Family History Department. Free, No subscription necessary
- ▶ Fold3® features premier collections of original military records. These records include the stories, photos, and personal documents of the men and women who served in the military. Membership is about \$80.00 per year
- ▶ Newspapers.com® is the largest online newspaper archive consisting of 617 million+ pages from 19,600+ newspapers. Newspapers provide a unique view of the past and can help us understand and connect with the people and events of an earlier time. Cost is about \$19.99 per month

Marriage Records

- ▶ Marriage records usually have good information that might help you.
- ▶ Age at marriage.
- ▶ Current residence.
- ▶ Where the persons getting married were born.
- ▶ Marriage license date - usually close to when marriage occurred.
- ▶ That they were not feeble minded, insane or related to each other.
- ▶ This example was from 1946

- ▶ Sometimes it shows almost the whole family and sometimes very little information.
- ▶ It usually tells you the date of death, place of death, where the person was buried, and when a funeral was held.
- ▶ Obituaries are most times written by a family member and posted in a local newspaper.
- ▶ They can provide information about the rest of the family.

- ▶ The date of birth.
- ▶ The certificate number associated with the birth of the child.
- ▶ Some birth records like birth certificates may contain the child's parents' names and address.

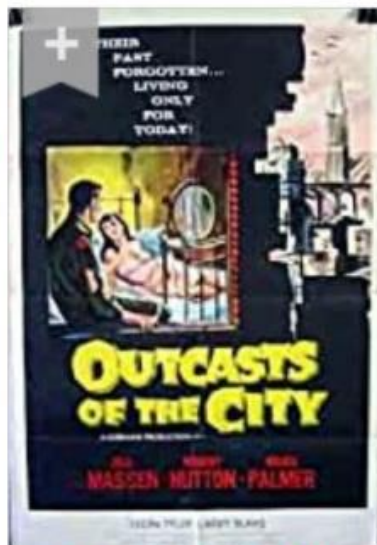

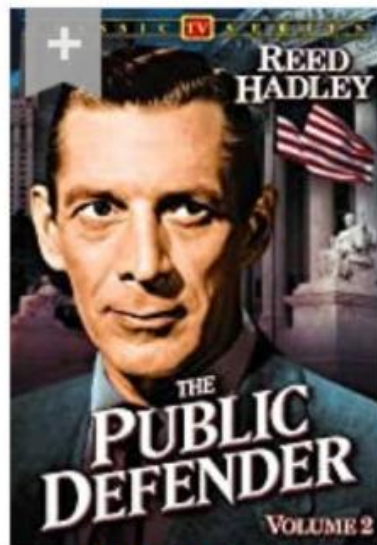

Immigration Records and Passenger Lists

- ▶ A great source of information can be found on several different types of Immigration records and passenger lists.
- ▶ Names and dates of registrant and spouse, children, date of birth, place of birth are just some of the information you will find about your ancestor.
- ▶ Passenger lists can help verify a Petition for Citizenship and for the Declaration of Intent.
- ▶ There are usually some discrepancies between documents.
- ▶ Always use common sense and verify what you can about the truth in documents

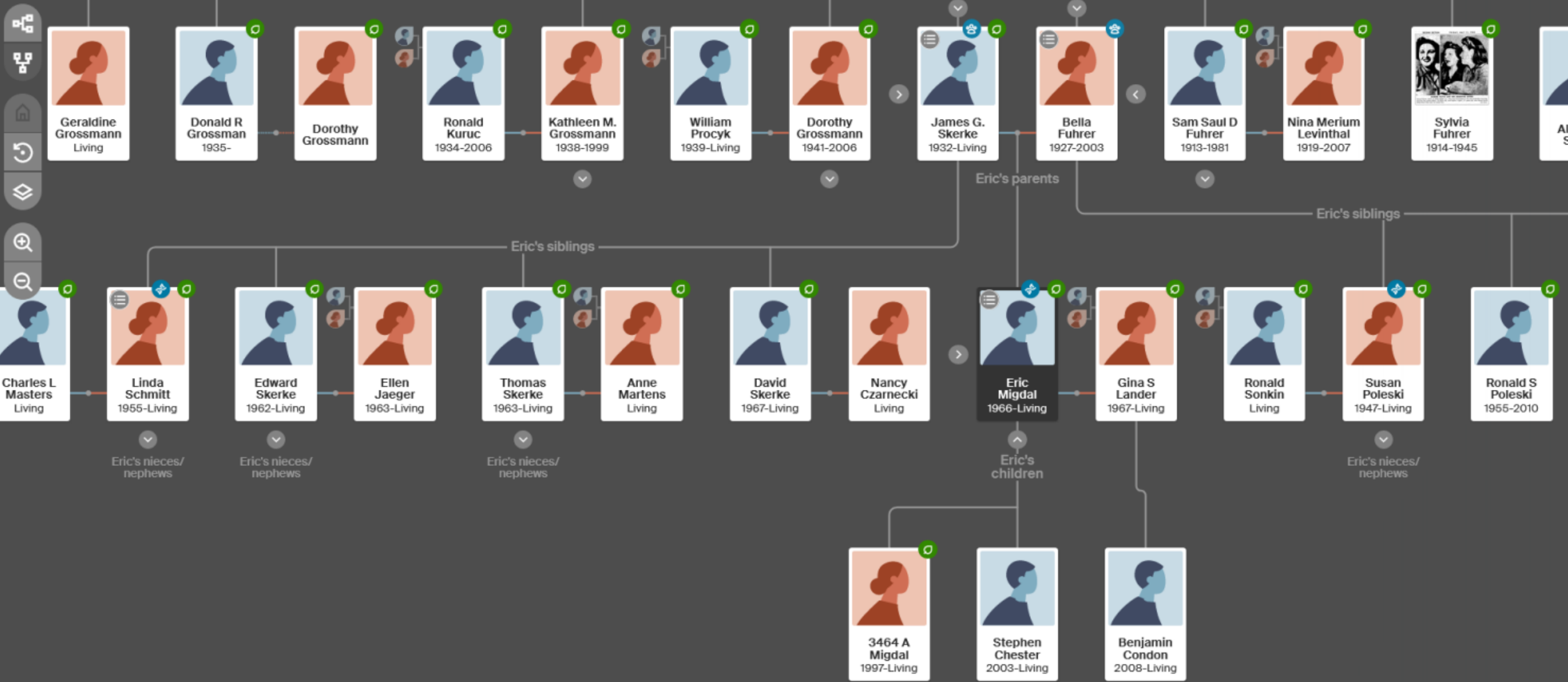
